Agenda Item and Minutes

89 Agenda Item No 1 – Apologies for Absence

Apologies were received from Parish Councillor Russell Jackson

90 Agenda Item No 2 - Declarations of Interests

The Chairman Cllr Richard Ford asked members to declare any interests they may have in relation to items on the agenda for this meeting.

Parish Councillor Richard Foord declared an interest in item 3 (a) (i) as an adjoining land owner. Parish Councillor Alyson Lownie declared an interest in item 5 as a payment recipient.

91 Agenda Item No 3 (a) – Planning applications

Members considered the following planning applications which had been submitted to TVBC:

- (i) TVBC Ref: 18/1419/OUTN
Address: Land north of junction of A30 and A3057. Leckford Lane, Stockbridge
Application Type Outline
Application for Erection of eight two bedroom semi-detached chalet bungalows in four blocks of two with access drive and car parking

Members considered the limited number of documents and plans that accompanied this outline planning application

Resolved: That the Parish Council objected unanimously to the application for a number of reasons, the primary one being that the proposed development was outside the existing settlement boundary. **ACTION:** The Parish Clerk is to convey the Parish Council's views to TVBC Planning Department.

 Address: Blandford House High Street Stockbridge SO20 6HB
 Application Type Full
 Application for Proposed first floor rear extension, and replacement of existing porch.
 Members considered the documents and plans that accompanied this planning application

Resolved: The Parish Council resolved unanimously that it had no objections to this application. **ACTION:** The Parish Clerk is to convey the Parish Council's views to TVBC Planning Department.

92 Agenda Item No 4 - Update from the Parish Council's Working Group on the consultation that the Parish Council is undertaking in respect of the proposed redevelopment of the Old Police Station and Copperknobs.

Parish Councillor Alyson Lownie provided members with an update on the proposals for finalising and distributing the consultation questionnaire and accompanying documents. It was agreed between members that the questionnaires would be distributed over the weekend of 11/12th August 2018. The consultation would end on Wednesday 29th August 2018.
